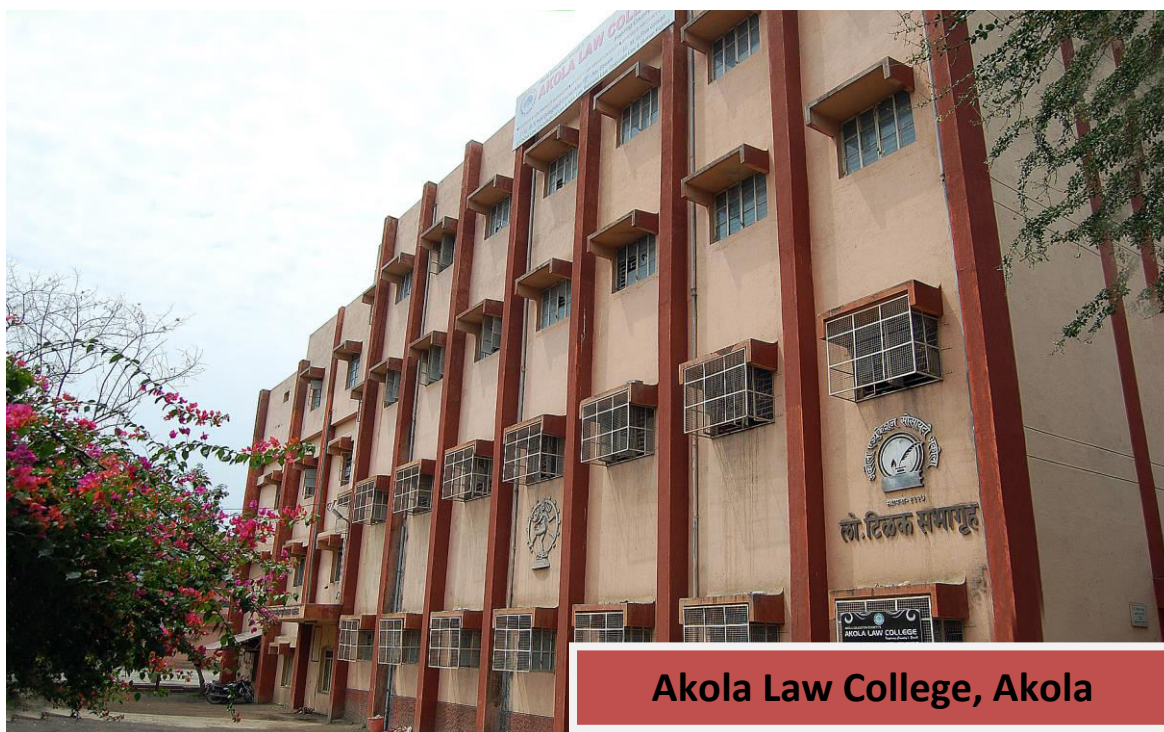

- **ADMISSION PROCESS FOR LL. B. COURSES:** For Admission in First Year of LL. B. Three Year Degree Course and LL. B. Five Year Integrated Course, students should pass MAH-LLB CET examination and go through CAP process regulated and conducted by DHE, Maharashtra
- **ELIGIBILITY FOR APPLYING FOR MAH-LLB CET:** Minimum 45% of Marks in aggregate, (candidate belonging to SC and ST Category need only 40% marks and VJNT, SBC and OBC Category with minimum 42% marks in the qualifying exam.
- **ELIGIBILITY FOR QUALIFYING EXAM :**
 - **LL. B. Three Year Degree Course:** Graduation in any faculty in the pattern of 10+2+3 with regular studies at Secondary and Higher Secondary schooling.
 - **LL. B. Five Year Integrated Course:** Senior Secondary School course (10+2) or equivalent (11+1, A level in Senior Secondary School Leaving Certificate course) from any Stream.
- **ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR LL. M. COURSE :**
 - 1) Issue of Application Forms - 1st July onwards.
 - 2) Admission - Up to first week of August or any date fixed by University.
 - 3) Admission will be made by the Admission Committee and with due approval from the Principal.
 - 4) Approved Admission forms will be accepted for admission along with fees mentioned in fees schedule during office hours.
- **ELIGIBILITY FOR LL. M. COURSE:** LL. B. with 50 percent.

5. Photocopy of Aadhaar Card
6. Certified copy of document indicating the date of birth.
7. Gap Certificate (if any gap in learning).
8. Migration Certificate (if from other University).
9. Non Creamy Layer Certificate.
10. Domicile Certificate.
11. Foreign students seeking admission should produce their passport and student visa at the time of admission. Those holding tourist visas or entry visas will not be considered.

Above documents must be submitted in original with attested 3 sets of photocopy and recent three passport size photographs, with name written on the backside. Admission must be taken by the student in person.

INFRASTRUCTURE AND OTHER FACILITIES:

Wi-Fi Campus: The College provides Wi-Fi facility for the students.

Library: The College has excellent library facility with more than 5000 books. Library is stacked up with books on law and allied subjects. The college also subscribes to Click-Judgment and Digilegal software for current and back volumes of A.I.R., Cr. L J., S.C.J., M.L.J., other journals and databases of Supreme Court cases, High Court cases and Central and State legislations. Book Bank Facility is available for the students on payment of necessary deposit.

Auditorium: The College has the auditorium and conference hall with a seating capacity of 300 persons.

Computer Laboratory with Internet Connectivity: The College has computer laboratory with adequate numbers of computers with internet facility. Students have free access to use the computer laboratory.

Legal Aid Clinic: To help the needy persons and to give the students the practical knowledge of law, the college has set up a 'Free Legal Aid Clinic'. The college organizes free legal aid camps, legal literacy camps, women & children rights awareness camps etc.

Games and Sports: Facilities for various games and sports are available in the college including play ground for volley ball, basket ball, cricket and other out-door games.

Scholarship and Concession: Government of India Scholarship is available for the students of S.T., S.C., O.B.C. and N.T. etc. The management will consider the grant of scholarship and fee concessions in selected deserving cases on receiving applications.

National Minority Scholarship: National Minority Scholarship is also available for those students who have from minority community.

Moot Court Hall: Moot Court room has been set up at the college with all required facilities including furniture, books and others. The college regularly organizes moot court activities.
